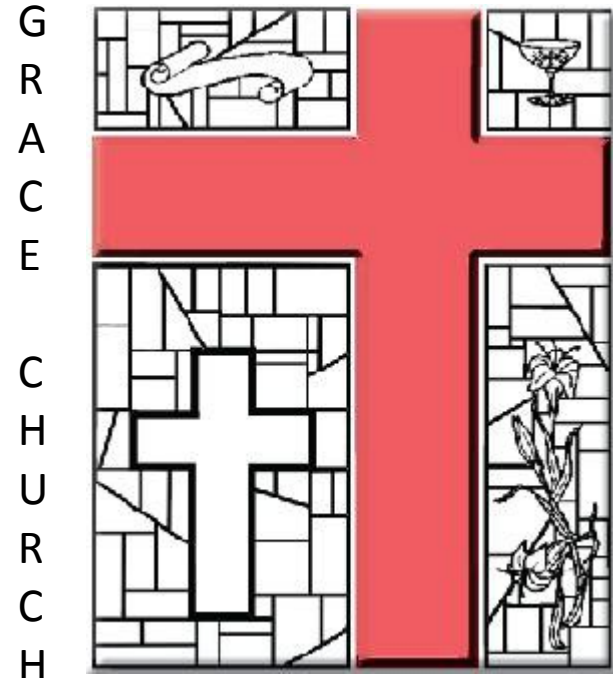

The Total Solar Eclipse

Monday, we will experience 93% of the total eclipse that is viewable further up in our state. The entire eclipse period will be from roughly 9:00 am to 11:30 am. There are some safety precautions you **must** take to keep your eyes safe.

Never look **directly** at the Sun. You can seriously hurt your eyes, and even go blind. Proper eye protection, like eclipse glasses are the only safe option. According to NASA, the following materials should **never be used** to view a solar eclipse:

- sunglasses of any kind
- color film
- medical x-ray film
- smoked glass
- floppy disks
- squinting eyes

The sun's UV radiation can burn the retinas in the eyes leading to permanent damage or even blindness. This can occur even if your eyes are exposed to direct sunlight for just a few seconds. Best ways to view are a pinhole projector (instructions on back table), watch it on TV (KDRV, KTVL, or KOB, locally), or live on the internet at...
