From the Pastor's Desk...

History Got It Right

While reading in the Gospel of John last week, a particular passage caught my eye. Let me summarize John 19:16-18 first. John tells us that Pilate delivered Jesus over to be crucified. Jesus carried his own cross to the place of the skull, or Golgotha, and there he was crucified between two others. And then we come to verse:

¹⁹ Pilate also wrote an inscription and put it on the cross. It read, "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews." ²⁰ Many of the Jews read this inscription, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city, and it was written in Aramaic, in Latin, and in Greek. ²¹ So the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, "Do not write, "The King of the Jews,' but rather, 'This man said, I am King of the Jews.'" ²² Pilate answered, "What I have written I have written."

Now in reading this passage of scripture there were three things that struck me as interesting. First, in verse 19 it says that Pilate wrote an inscription and put it on the cross. Now this was done to signify the charge or charges that were being brought against the person who was being crucified on the cross. Pilate wrote "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews."

We also see in verse 20 that it was written in three languages; Aramaic, Latin and Greek. This would be so all people could read the charges. And then we see in verse 21 that the chief priests of the Jews challenged what Pilate had written. They said "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews,' but rather, 'This man said, I am King of the Jews.'"

In this action they took, it is clear that they were wanting to say, instead of Jesus being who He said He was, that was only a "claim" He was making. They disputed it. They wanted to take away the greater that He was, and make Him lesser than His greatness.

Wisely however, Pilate's reply to them is clear. Pilate said "What I have written I have written." He was saying "this is the fact as I see it, and no, I have no intention of changing it for you or anyone else."

So this is why I say "history got it right." Pilate stated clearly, succinctly, and in three languages as well, "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews." So what does this mean to us? It's a reminder that even in His death, the personage of Jesus, along with His title, would not and could not be questioned. This was the One who would shortly die on that cross, be buried, and raised to life after three days. And then go on to ascend to heaven, be seated at the right hand of the Father and ever make intercession for us.

Because history got it right, there can be no question when we are sharing the good news with others; that Jesus is King of the Jews. It was stated clearly, concisely, authoritatively, and in three languages. The Jewish people missed their King, but Pilate stated it clearly and history got it right.

But think about this: even in the change the chief priests desired, the truth would still have been told. Think about the inscription they wanted, "This man said 'I am King of the Jews." Yes, He was and is, and always will be, the great "I am." Even if changed, history still would have gotten it right!
