From the Pastor's Desk...

Praise and Thanksgiving

This month I'd like us to take a few minutes to think about "praise" and "thanksgiving." Now, the *thanksgiving* I'm talking about is not the day we celebrate, feasting on turkey or ham. No, I'm thinking of the word "thanksgiving" which means "to give thanks." It seems sometimes we *thank* when we mean to *praise* and vice versa. So, what exactly are *praise* and *thanksgiving?* How are they the same and how are they different?

Praise is giving God the glory for Who He is, for His attributes, for the privilege extended to allow each of us to lift up His holy name. Take a moment right now to look up Psalm 150 in your Bible. Read it slowly, filtering what you read against the description just shared of what praise is. In praise we lift up God's goodness, knowledge, power, wisdom, mercy, grace, holiness, love, greatness and patience. When we praise we are focused totally on God as He stands alone. Praise is not thanking God for anything, just acknowledging Who He is in His greatness and power and glory and... well, you get the idea. If you really want to praise God joyfully, take time to write down all the attributes you can think of that make up who God is. This would include words that are maybe not as prevalent in our praise, but could be, such as creative, decisive, selective and immutable(unchanging). When we take time to praise God, it's a good reminder to us of Who He is, and consequently who we

Thanksgiving on the other hand is thanking God, pure and simple. Thanksgiving is acknowledging what God has done, is doing, or will do. It is our opportunity to tell God what we are thankful for that He has provided to us. And remember, "every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change (James 1:17). It could be material blessings, physical blessings, spiritual blessings, or people that God has brought into our lives for a purpose. For all of these we need to give thanks. Again, I'll ask you to take a moment and read Psalm 136, and as you read it, focus on what is says God does, is doing, and has done.

Of course, it is not as cut and dried as it seems. *Praise* and *thanksgiving* really go together. *Praise* and *thanksgiving* please the heart of God. They are both necessary components of our prayer life. They express our faith, hope, love and gratitude.

They acknowledge His way is better than our way, always. In summary, *praise* is extolling God for Who He is and an expression of our love for Him and praise for His character. *Thanksgiving* is to thank God for what He has done and is an expression of our gratitude and our thanking Him for His actions. One last passage to read, Psalm 106:1-3; it's a psalm of *praise* and *thanksgiving!* Indeed, God deserves our *praise* and we have so very much from Him for which to be *thankful!*
