Operation Christmas Child, (Shoebox)



At this time more than 11 million "Operation Christmas Child" shoebox gifts are traveling to more than 100 countries. Grace church collected, packed and sent 81 boxes. Each child receiving this gift hears that Jesus loves them and that God sent His son Jesus as the greatest Gift.

We at Grace, plan to participate in the "Made in Southern Oregon" bazaar in downtown Central Point this September, to help offset the costs of filling and sending shoeboxes.

This exposure will represent Grace Church and Samaritan's Purse shoebox ministry to the community. We will have flyers with information and service schedules inviting shoppers to Grace, and information concerning the purpose of the shoebox ministry of Samaritan's Purse.
