Peter's Denial of Christ - Mark 14:27-72

1. **Over-C** \_\_\_\_\_  
*Everyone else may stumble in their faith, but I will not!* vs. 29
2. **L** \_\_\_\_\_  
*Couldn't you stay awake with Me for one hour?* vs. 37
3. **F** \_\_\_\_\_ of **D** \_\_\_\_\_  
*Peter followed Him at a distance...* vs. 54a
4. **C** \_\_\_\_\_  
*He sat with the guards and warmed himself at the fire.* vs. 54b

**GOD'S RESPONSE:** *There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.* Romans 8:1

## II. WHY DOESN'T GOD REJECT BELIEVERS WHEN WE SIN?

1. **BECAUSE HIS LOVE IS U** \_\_\_\_\_  
*Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed,  
for His compassions never fail.* Lamentations 3:22
2. **BECAUSE SALVATION IS NOT BASED ON P** \_\_\_\_\_  
*He saved us, not because of the good things we did,  
but because of His mercy.* Titus 3:5
3. **BECAUSE JESUS TOOK MY P** \_\_\_\_\_  
*When Jesus served as a sacrifice for our sins, He solved the sin  
problem for God -not only ours, but the whole world's.* 1 John 2:2<sup>M</sup>
4. **BECAUSE JESUS UNDERSTANDS My W** \_\_\_\_\_  
*(He) has been tempted in every way, just as we are --  
yet was without sin.* Hebrews 4:15

5. **BECAUSE GOD DOESN'T HOLD G** \_\_\_\_\_  
*The Lord...will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger  
forever; He does not treat us as our sins deserve ...As a father has  
compassion on His children, so the LORD has compassion on those  
who fear him.* Psalm 103:8-9, 13

*Come back to Me, you faithful children, and I will forgive  
you for being unfaithful.* Jeremiah 3:22<sup>NCV</sup>

III. WHAT SHOULD I DO WHEN I SIN? **R** \_\_\_\_\_

*If you repent, I will restore you that you may serve me...  
[If you return to Me ...<sup>NLT</sup>]* Jeremiah 15:19

*No matter how deep the stain of your sins, I can take it out  
and make you clean as freshly fallen snow.* Isaiah 1:18<sup>LB</sup>

*...with deep compassion I will bring you back.* Isaiah 54:7

*Jesus... is able to save completely all who come to God through  
Him. Since He will live forever, He will always be there to remind  
God that He has paid for their sins with His blood.* Hebrews 7:25<sup>LB</sup>

*Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me  
a willing spirit, to sustain me.* Psalm 51:12

**Pray this:** *Jesus, You know I've wandered away. My love &  
commitment to You is not like it should be. Thank You for Your  
unconditional love; You've never stopped loving me. Thank You  
that my salvation isn't based on my performance. Jesus, I thank  
You for taking all the punishment for my sins. Thank You, Jesus,  
that You understand & sympathize with my human weaknesses.*

*I want to thank You that You don't hold onto grudges & that  
You're not angry with me. By Grace, I ask You to take me back  
today. I come home to Your open loving arms. I want to follow You  
by Grace. I come back home today.*

**Now, if you've never invited Christ into your life, pray,**  
*"Jesus Christ, I don't understand it all but I accept what You did  
for me, Your forgiveness, Your grace. I want to be a part of Your  
family. I want to follow You. In Jesus name I pray. Amen."*
