The Good Shepherd John 10:1-18

I. The G_____ - the Good Shepherd's
Relationship to His Sheep

Jesus tells the parable of the s_____ and the sheepfold.

John 10:1-6

I tell you the truth, the man who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber. ² The man who enters by the gate is the shepherd of his sheep. ³ The watchman opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. ⁴ When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. ⁵ But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice.

II. The Shepherd C_____ for His Sheep
John 10:7-10

Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. All who ever came before Me were thieves & robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through Me will be saved. He will come in & go out, & find pasture. The thief comes only to steal & kill & destroy; I have come that they may have life, & have it to the full.

III. The Shepherd's H_____ for His Sheep
John 10:10-15

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep & runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock & scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand & cares nothing for the sheep. I am the Good Shepherd; I know my sheep & my sheep know me — just as the Father knows me & I know the Father — & I lay down my life for the sheep.
